## High Jump

Designed for high school students who have demonstrated the academic achievement and maturity needed to enroll in college courses during their senior year. Seniors who study at TRCC full-time are eligible to earn college credit *and* credit for high school graduation.

Students must have a cumulative 3.0 (B) high school GPA and permission of their parents or guardians.

## College Career Pathways (Tech Prep)

A four to six year program that begins in high school and culminates with an Associate or Bachelor's Degree. The program provides a planned high school curriculum that includes math, science, communications, and a career component. CCP allows high schools students to earn up to 15 college credits free.

Students are accepted on the basis on their guidance counselor's recommendation.

## High School Partnership

Offers high school juniors and seniors the chance to earn college credit by attending TRCC on a scholarship. Students are required to take a computerized placement test before acceptance. The scholarship covers the cost of tuition and most fees.

High school students must maintain a minimum 3.0 (B) GPA and attend a school participating in the program.
